

Village of Nassau Police Department
Monthly Report
December 2021

Enclosed are the monthly reports for arrests, incidents, traffic tickets and auto accidents.
There was 1 arrest, 36 incidents and 1 property damage auto accident investigated.
A total of 44 traffic stops were conducted and 22 traffic tickets were issued.

Current Vehicle mileage:

Unit 602 - 2016 Ford Interceptor Utility – approximately 56,426 Miles
Unit 603 - 2020 Ford Interceptor Utility – approximately 10,075 Miles

Items of interest:

- 1) There were 4 Penal Law Investigations – 1- Burglary, 2 - Larceny, 1- Harassment – which were closed by investigation. There is 1 open Alcohol Beverage and Control (ABC) law case being investigated.
- 2) On 11/2/21 the Nassau Police began an investigation with regards to the B&M Petroleum and Food Mart on Church St., who were allegedly selling alcohol to minors. A complaint/referral was made by our department to the New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) requesting an investigation. Nassau officers monitored the store during the course of their shifts (looking for minors purchasing alcohol). On or about the week of 12/13 /21 the SLA along with Rensselaer County Sheriff's Investigators conducted a "sting" type underage purchase of alcohol from said establishment and a clerk was arrested for sale to a minor and was arraigned in Nassau Village Court on 1/4/22. The establishment's liquor license is under review by the SLA. It is more than likely that the establishment will be fined, but will be able to continue to sell alcohol. It is our understanding that the clerk who was arrested has been fired.
- 3) Information was received by the law enforcement and education communities that there was a call via social media for mass violence in schools throughout the country on 12/17/21. On 12/16/21 DPS Principal Jack Alvey contacted Chief Colonno and requested a police presence during school hours on 12/17/21. Officer D. Bunney and K9 Vader were assigned (special detail) to the school throughout the day on 12/17/21 to do numerous foot and vehicular patrols in and around the school and property. There were no incidents to note.
- 4) On 12/30/21 the Nassau Police and the New York State Police were dispatched to the area of Church St. for a possible intoxicated driver operating NY registration JJC5629.
